

Feel more confident buying online with this step by step guide to help you correctly measure your child's feet.



**1. Print out the gauge.**

Ensuring your printer is set to 100% or 'do not scale', print out the gauge and measure.



**2. Place the chart on a hard surface.**

The back of your child's heel should be in line with the thick bottom line. For ease and best results, you may want to position the heel line against a wall.

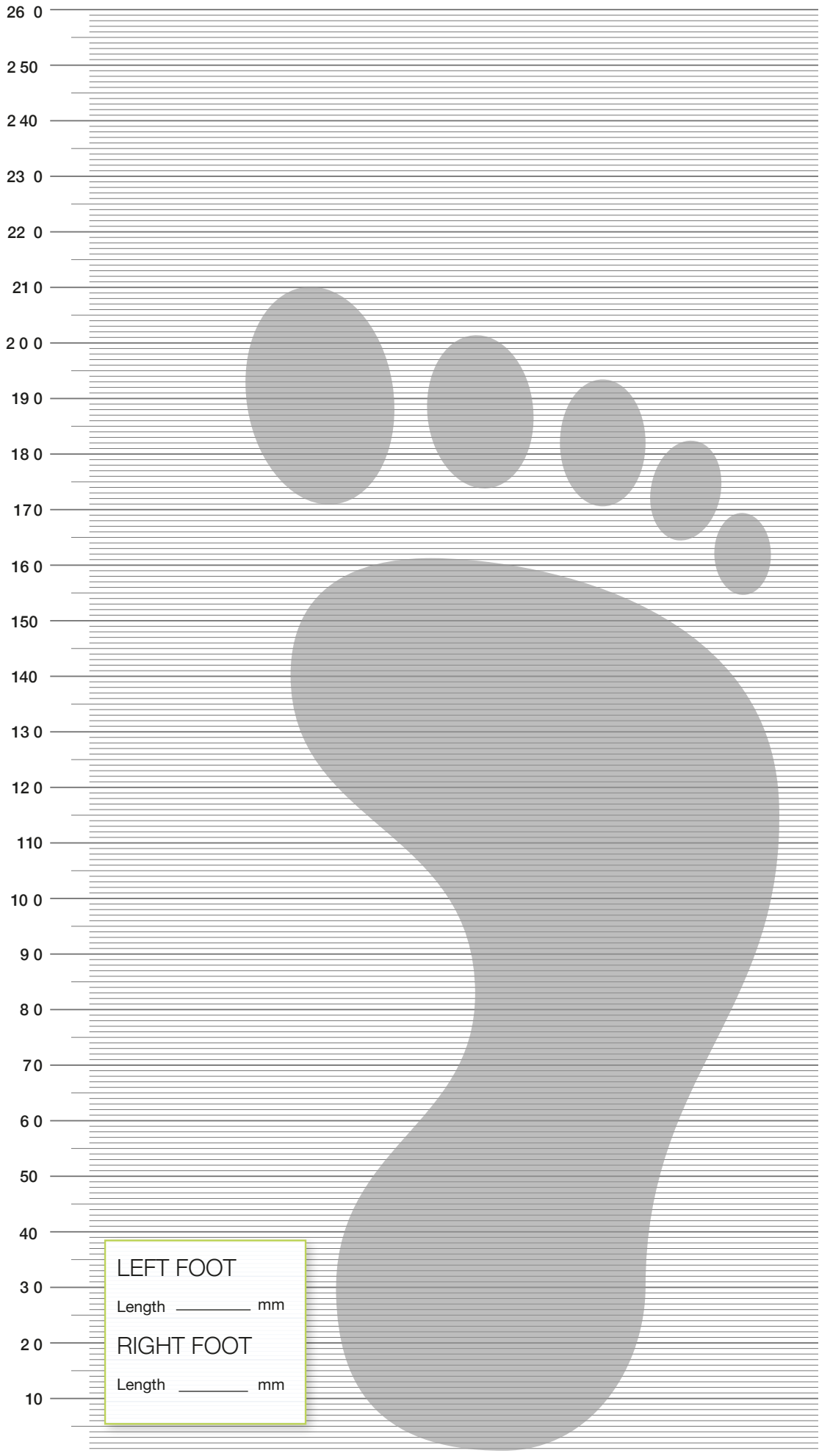


**3. Measure both feet.**

You need to measure the maximum length of each foot. There is no need to allow any extra room, we have done that for you.
